Inspire Remote Learning - Update

Learning whilst my child is at home....

This week we added Remote Learning resources for Year 3 and 6 as our first week trial. You access these through Stockingford Academy website and by clicking on the Remote Learning tab on the Home Page. These are directly linked to the learning that is happening in your child's classroom each week with PDF slides, video-clips and resource sheets. We will continue to add more year groups next week.

What happens if I don't have the right technology at home?

To find out how we can support families at home access and use our Remote Learning resources, we have put together a brief Remote Learning Survey Monkey Questionnaire. This will enable us to support families where there isn't any device, or one device is being shared amongst a number of children/ adults. This may become an issue to access Remote Learning resources if everyone has to self-isolate for a period of time. The Department for Education are providing schools with some technology support to distribute to families but we are looking for ways to increase this at Stockingford Academy.
