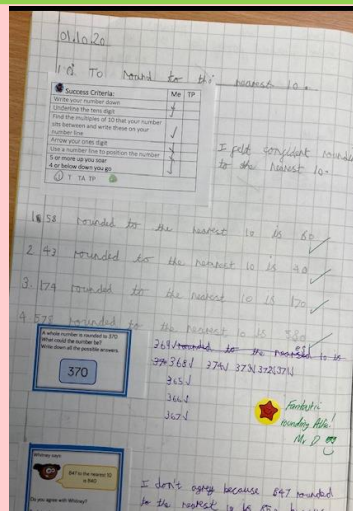
It's week 3 of our Celebration Newsletter and we have seen some amazing learning from our wonderful children. Here are some highlights from a fantastic week. Happy Friday!
