Music Lessons

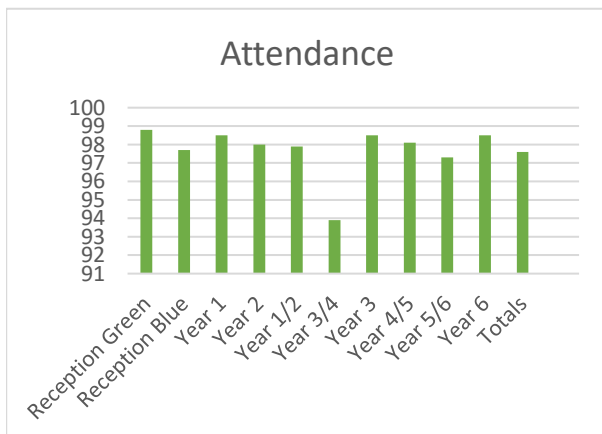
