Next week's 'statement to live by' is:

It would be lovely if you could carry on spending some time at home examining the statement in the family.

To help us all have a smooth start to the school day, doors will open at **8:35am** and children can go straight into their classes, as learning starts promptly at **8:45am**.

Please can we remind you not to enter school via the pupils' entrance/exit doors. If at any time, you wish to see your child's class Teacher you should now make an appointment via telephoning or emailing the School Office or use class Dojo. Your child's class teacher will contact you as soon as they possible can. Thank you.

May I remind parents that all uniform and clothing in school must be marked with a permanent marker or name tag. Respectfully, we request that children strictly follow the Governors' policies by not bringing chewing gum into school. Children are expected to wear school shoes in school (**trainers are not allowed**). Please ensure your child come to school in their PE kit on their allocated PE day.

Could we remind parents, to ensure the health and safety of our children and parents, **DOGS are NOT ALLOWED** anywhere on our school land/premises and we are a **NO SMOKING** site.

SOCIAL MEDIA - We have been made aware that some online social media websites have been allowing the publication of extremely distressing posts. If you, or your child, require any support as a result of this, please contact school.

Please carefully monitor your child's internet usage, ensure that parental controls are applied – particularly with sites such as YouTube, Tik-Toc, Facebook, Instagram etc, some of which children of primary school age should not be using. Thank you

JEWELLERY - Please ensure that your child does not wear jewellery in school. This applies to earrings, other rings, necklaces and bracelets. This a Governors policy and part of our contract / partnership with parents.

CHILDREN WALKING HOME FROM SCHOOL - It is only the children in Year 6 who are allowed to walk home on their own, without being collected by an adult. If parents wish to allow this, they must put their request in writing to Mr Harrison.

As the children are still in the responsibility of the school at the end of the day, we must consider whether the child is safe to leave school unaccompanied. If we have concerns here, we will contact parents so that a conversation can take place. Concerns often relate to the individual child, such as the nature of their journey home, who they are meeting on that journey, and level of maturity of the child. In previous years we have been able to reach agreement with parents with regards to this matter.

When we approve that a child may walk home, this only applies to the child in Year 6 and not their younger siblings.

USE OF MOBILE PHONES - The Governors' policy is explicit here – mobile phones are not allowed in school for any purpose. This issue has been discussed in enormous depth and extensive advice taken. On safeguarding and security grounds we ask parents to ensure that phones are not brought into school. If this happens, the phone will be removed from the child and only returned to the parents at a later date. The office will not look after phones during the day. Children who carry phones are at considerably more risk than those that don't.

If you have not already done so please download the **School Gateway** app – a parent engagement app that will allow you to communicate with the school from anywhere, pay for dinner money, school trips, music tuition etc, it gives you:-

- Secure, convenient ways to pay via the website or the [ParentApp](#)
- Choice of payment options
- Ability to give permission online for trips – no more lost slips
- Pay and top up balances at any time
- View multiple children on one account
- Pay for multiple items at the same time

All school related [communication](#), [newsletters](#), [trip consents and payments](#) will go through School Gateway. To stay up to date with what's going on at school make sure you download the app for free. Just search **School Gateway** in your App store and download. Your login details will be automatically generated using the contact information SS Aidan & Oswald already has, so please make sure the details we hold for you are up to date. You can also login to the online version of School Gateway via this site if you do not have a smart phone, although we do recommend using the app if possible as it makes it far easier to get hold of parents when we need to.

Oldham free school meals – are you eligible? - Oldham Council is urging families to check whether they are eligible for free school meals for the next academic year in September 2020. The Coronavirus Pandemic has left many families with different financial situations than before. The worry is that more children will be left facing hunger and malnutrition because parents and guardians are struggling financially and aren't aware of what they are eligible to claim.

You don't need to make a separate claim for free school meals if you are already in receipt or have applied for Housing Benefit or help with your Council Tax. Oldham Council will use the information and evidence we have already provided to confirm your entitlement to free school meals.

If you live outside the borough (except Manchester) and your child goes to an Oldham school. Then you will need to apply through your local council in the area where you live.

If you have children in **NURSERY/KS2 JUNIORS**, the cost of school dinners is **£12.00 per week**. **This is payable on the SCHOOL GATEWAY.**

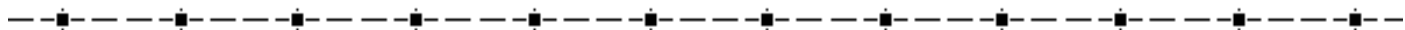
