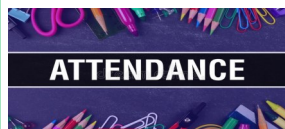
Well done to **Joshua, Year 1**, our music star of the week for taking an active part in Music lesson this week.

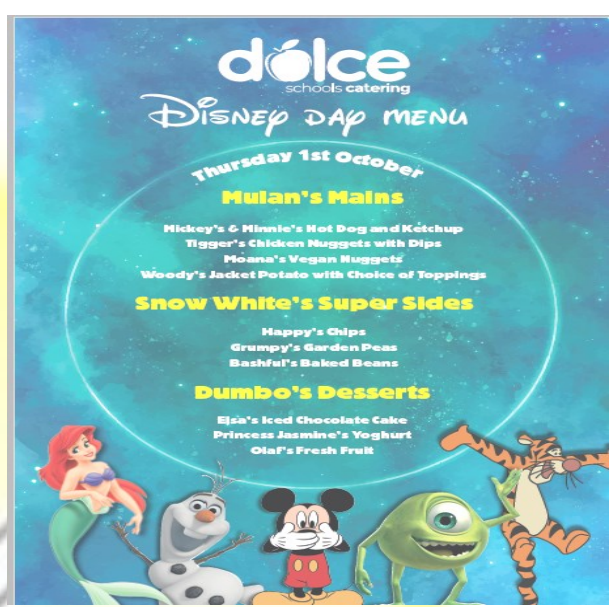


Virtual Open Evening 2020
