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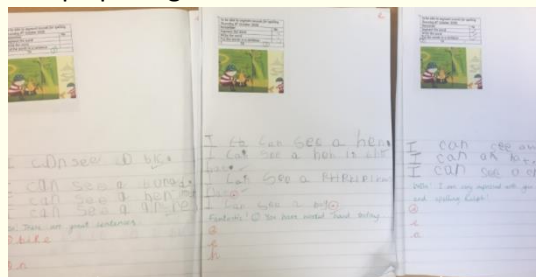

Year 5

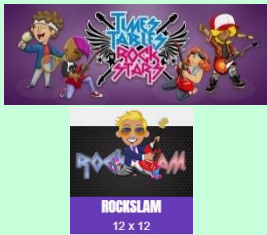
5P: Leighton for persevering in art lessons and making excellent progress with his sketching skills.
