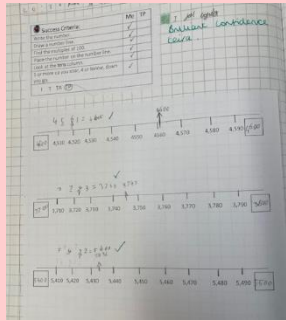
Success Criteria:

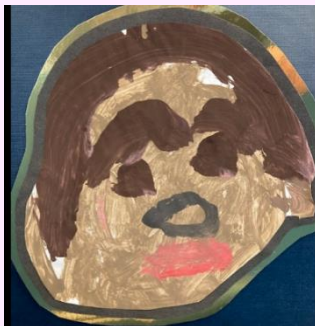
