A super week playing and learning for the Robins! In phonics, we have learned the next 3 sounds: **c**, **k**, and **ck**. We have also learned the tricky word **go**; we can't sound the tricky words out we just have to learn them so keep practising! In our maths sessions we continued to learn about number 2, we learned about shapes that have 2 sides and began to use mathematical terms to describe shapes and have used shapes to create models and patterns. Has your child remembered the names of the shapes, semi-circle, hemisphere and cone?

Thank you to everyone who added an observation on tapestry last week, the children are learning to talk confidently about the things they do at home!
