

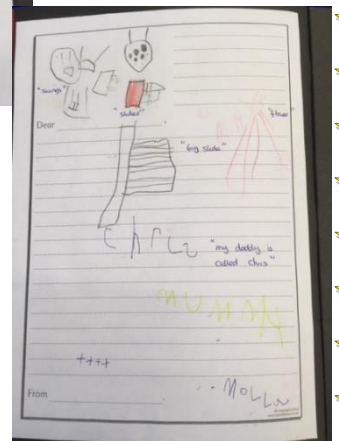
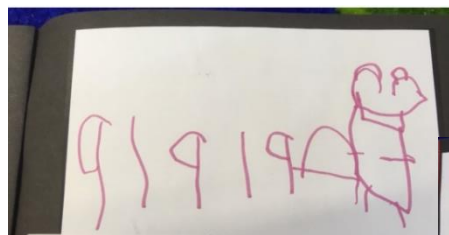
Nursery End of Term 1 Celebration Newsletter. Term 1
