## Dear Parents,

Recently, the children have been learning how to recognise and write their name. In the Nursery, the children have been tracing their name and then have tried to write their name independently.

We would be grateful if you could help your child practice writing their name over the half term holiday. You could write your child's name with a highlighter and encourage them to trace over their name a few times and they can then have a go at writing it independently underneath.

Only the first letter in your child's name should be a capital letter.
