**Christmas at St. Anne's:** because of the various restrictions this year people have been asking about the celebration of Holy Mass. The Bishop reminds us, particularly this year, to remember that the Octave of Christmas means that from 25th December - 1st January every day is seen by the Church as Christmas Day and if we are unable to book a seat for Christmas Eve or Christmas Day there will be plenty of seats for the daily Christmas Mass which concludes on 1st January the end of the Octave with the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God.

24th December: Vigil Mass for Christmas: 4.00pm; Mass of Christmas Night: 11.00pm

25th December: Mass of Christmas Day: 11.00am

26th/27th December: Mass 10.00am (St. Stephen) Vigil Mass: 6.30pm & Sunday: 11am (Feast of the Holy Family)

Monday 28th December - Friday 1st January: Holy Mass every day at 10.00am.
