Your Child's Progress Reports

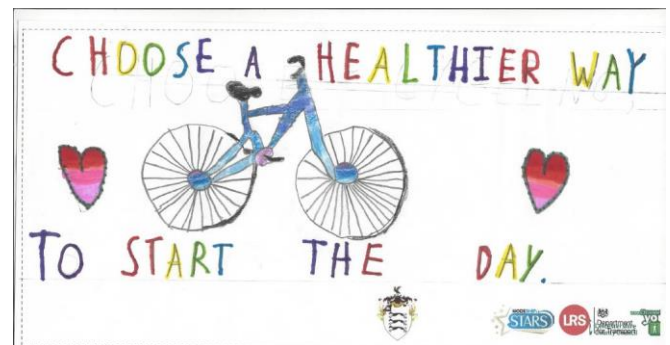
You will have received a second progress sheet for your child in Years 1-6, last week via email.

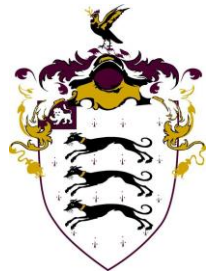


REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY
