Christmas at St. Anne's: because of the various restrictions this year people have been asking about the celebration of Holy Mass. The Bishop reminds us, particularly this year, to remember that the Octave of Christmas means that from 25th December - 1st January every day is seen by the Church as Christmas Day and if we are unable to book a seat for Christmas Eve or Christmas Day there will be plenty of seats for the daily Christmas Mass which concludes on 1st January the end of the Octave with the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God.

24th December: Vigil Mass for Christmas: 4.00pm; Mass of Christmas Night: 11.00pm

25th December: Mass of Christmas Day: 11.00am

26th/27th December: Mass 10.00am (St. Stephen) Vigil Mass: 6.30pm & Sunday: 11am (Feast of the Holy Family)

Monday 28th December - Friday 1st January: Holy Mass every day at 10.00am.

It is essential to book a place for Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Go to the parish website or phone:

Remember 2 people from the same house 1 ticket or a family from the same house or bubble 2 tickets only.

Preparation for Confirmation: the fifth lesson is on Monday 23rd November from 6.30pm - 7.30pm.

The November Dead List: The special book on the altar with the names of our dear departed family and friends will remain on the altar until December because of the lockdown in November.

Preparation for First Confession: this begins as an on-line course on Monday 11th January 2021 at 6.30pm.

There will be six lessons after the introduction and the First Confessions will be celebrated in St. Anne's Church on Saturday 6th March at 10.30am and the Certificates will be presented at Sunday Mass on 7th March at 11.00am.

The application forms can be collected from the sacristy after Saturday Vigil or Sunday Mass (6.30pm or 11.00am) from Sunday 6th December 2020. The forms should be returned to church with a £5.00 donation towards the cost of the Preparation book called "Jesus Comes to Me" which is also used next year for First Holy Communion Preparation. When the books are given out, at the end of December, they will include the instructions about using the interactive lessons on Zoom. Please phone Fr. Michael if you have any queries.
