Dear parents, pupils, governors, staff and parishioners,

We have had another busy week in school. This week all classes have had sessions linked to Anti Bullying as well as taking part in Odd Socks Day on Monday and having this as their assembly theme.



Blended Learning

We have been revising our approach to Blended Learning and more details will be sent home with the children next week. We are going to introduce the use of Microsoft Teams as a way to post work/videos to children who are isolating and have this as our main tool if a bubble needs to work from home. Every child will come home with a password that they can use to access this and details of what to do and where to post work

back. Children will also come home with a blank exercise book that is to be used if they need to work from home – can this be kept in a safe place so that we know children are able to have it to hand should a bubble be out.

The use of Microsoft Teams obviously relies on children being able to access a device and internet for some part of a day should they be working from home. If this is not available, we need to know as soon as possible please so that paper packs can be organised or the possible borrowing of devices could be arranged. If you do not have internet at home or a device that could be shared can you let us know by Monday 23rd November so we can put plans in place. A short message via Dojo to your Child's class teacher or filling in the form attached at the end of the Newsletter and handing it in on Monday will be appreciated – otherwise we will assume that your child has access at home.
