SCHOOL UPDATES

Messages from Public Health

Public Health has asked all North Yorkshire Schools to pass on the following messages:

- Please ensure that you maintain social distancing from others when dropping off and collecting your child from school.
- We recommend that all parents /carers entering the school premises (and in other congested areas around the school premises) wear a face covering in addition to social distancing. This is an extra safeguard to reduce the transmission of the virus. Please note that this does not apply to those who are medically exempt.
- You must keep at least two metres apart from other parents/ carers at all times. Where you are able to do so, wear a face covering.

- Limit the number of people they walk to / from school with.

Nigel Carson's Football Club will continue as normal.


