Dear Parents,

Welcome to Year Four at Lyminster. This term we have lots of exciting to ensure all of our children enjoy and excel in their learning.

Our Topic – Island Life (Fire and Ice)

Our topic this half term is all about living on an Island, specifically Iceland and the UK. We will delve into Island life, learn about the different landmasses and how they form, explore Icelandic 'Stone Troll' folklore, as well as the effects of climate change and how we can lower our carbon footprint. We will be reading lots of related stories such as *'Song of the Dolphin Boy'* by Elizabeth Laird, and poetry such as 'If You've Ever Lived on an Island' by J. Earnhart, to link our English work to Geography. By the end of the topic, the children will have a good working knowledge of different Islands and will be able to protect and preserve their way of life.

Homework

Year Four's homework will consist of daily reading, weekly spellings and mental maths. Weekly spellings are available in the Year 4 section of the Lyminster website. In addition, we will be setting online weekly My Maths homework and 15 minutes of Times Table Rock Stars in preparation for the multiplication test at the end of Year 4. In class, we will be changing reading and library books on a weekly basis. The children will always have at least two books to read at home and we ask that you read as much as you can.

Reading

It is important that your child's reading books are in their book bag every day as we like to take every opportunity to read! At home, please encourage your child to read widely across both fiction and non-fiction. **Our reading focus this half-term will be reading, understanding and discussing new vocabulary.** Reading widely and often increases pupils' vocabulary because they encounter words they would rarely hear or use in everyday speech. It would really support your child if you could help them to do this. Please also continue to read aloud more difficult texts and favourite books to your child, as we will also be sharing challenging books with the children in our daily reading lessons.

Handwriting

During Year Four, your child is expected to write neatly, using finger spaces, with 'lead-ins' at the start of each lower case letter. They should also be starting to join some of their lower case letters, so please encourage your child to practise at home. Don't forget that you also have free access to our handwriting website:
