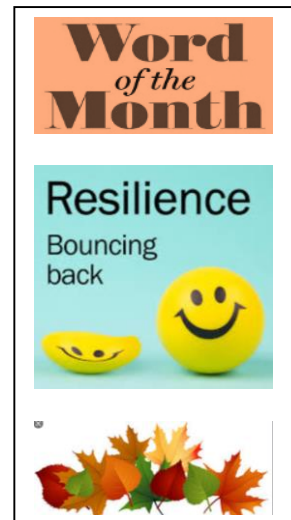


Thursday 26th November
