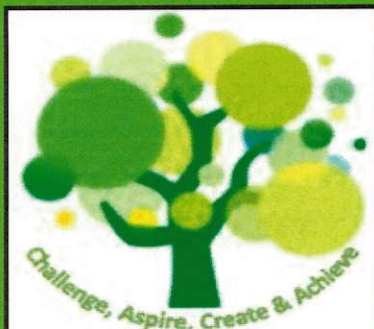

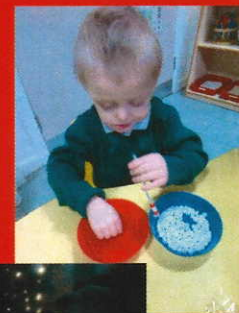

All the children have been working really hard to make decorations for our trees in school AND our lovely trees outside!!! Keep your eyes peeled and see what you can spot!!



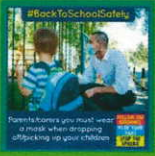

### Staying Safe



Please can I reiterate how important it is that we continue to follow the rules in the coming weeks and months. Please ensure that you are wearing a mask when picking up/ dropping off and that the mask is worn properly over the nose and mouth. Masks must be worn until you leave the school premises. Tuesday 5th January—Return to school

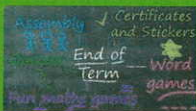


### Christmas raffle
