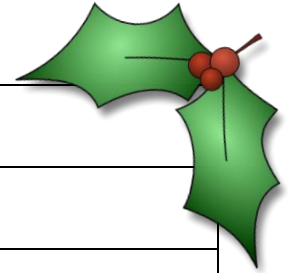
Superstars
