
Monday 14th December - Snowman performance for Park Hill children

Parents may be aware that the Department for Education made an announcement on Tuesday afternoon about the use of a teacher training day at the end of this term.

To ensure that staff get the time off they need and deserve, schools may wish to use an INSET day, making Friday 18 December a non-teaching day and using the day for staff training, which could be delivered online.

I and my team remain happy to be available over the holiday for information sharing on positive cases and accessible to test and trace. Our teacher training days are very valuable; they provide important time for staff to develop their skills and require planning and preparation - moving our planned day from January to December would not be beneficial to staff or to children. Any change would also mean that parents would need to change childcare plans at short notice.

For all the reasons outlined above our schools will stay open as planned.

Covid Cases at Park Hill

Many parents will already be aware that we have had an outbreak of coronavirus at Park Hill this week. Fortunately we have not had anyone who has become very unwell and our school community seem to be recovering quickly. Thank you to everyone who is helping to keep our community safe by following our guidance about face coverings on site and hand sanitiser on arrival. The increased hygiene measures and *hands, face, space* have certainly helped to reduce the spread of the infection.


We all need to remain vigilant by watching out for symptoms of coronavirus. The symptoms are:

- · a new continuous cough
- and/or high temperature
- and a loss of or change in normal sense of taste or smell

If you or your child shows these symptoms:

- do not come to school
- inform the school of the situation.
- self-isolate with your household
- book a test immediately

Please remain alert to your child being unwell, the top three symptoms above are more likely to be symptoms of Coronavirus. We have found that many children didn't display the main three signs of Coronavirus; their symptoms were a sore throat, or feeling really unwell, or muscle aches and pains. Although presentation of these symptoms is more likely to be a cold rather than Coronavirus.



Christmas Cards

We appreciate that children want to send Christmas cards to their friends and we want this to happen whilst taking into account Covid precautions. Therefore, children can bring cards into school on Mondays and Tuesdays. Children are asked to put their cards into their class letter box and they will then be quarantined for 72 hours. We will sort the post and give out cards on a Friday so that children may take them home. The cards should be for people in our schools; can everyone please write the name and class of the person on the envelope. Last post Tuesday 15th December.
