Further to my letter yesterday and the subsequent announcement from the Department for Education that all London primary schools remain closed for all pupils apart from children of Key Workers and Vulnerable pupils, I am writing to invite you to apply for a place if you are a Key Worker with no other means of child care.

Once again, clearly the intention is to have as few pupils on site as possible. **DO NOT** apply for a place unless it is vital and you have no means of child care. The whole point of this move is to ensure the maximum safety conditions for staff and children.
