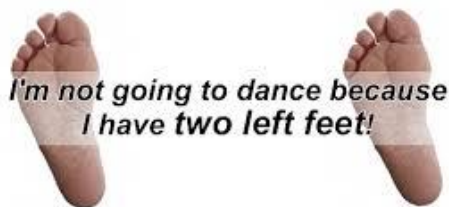
Dear parents / carers,

*idiom:* **two left feet**




*I'm not going to dance because I have **two left feet!***
