

School Meals and Packed Lunches

The academy provides a healthy, hot meal with a vegetarian alternative. Payment for this is weekly and should be sent on Monday in **a sealed envelope clearly marked with the child's full name and class. Payment can also be made on-line.** If your child wishes to change from packed lunches to dinners or vice versa, then the office staff must be informed at least one week in advance.
