Dear Parents and Carers,

Re. Schools requesting mobile data increases for families

Through the Government's 'Get Help with Technology' scheme, schools are able to request on your behalf for temporary increases in data allowances for mobile phone users on certain networks. This is to ensure that all children are able to access remote education.

Who can get help

Help is available to families that meet all 4 of these criteria:

- families who have children in Year 3 to 11
- do not have fixed broadband at home
- cannot afford additional data for their devices
- are home-schooling

Which mobile networks can increase data

Children with access to a mobile phone on one of the following networks might be able to benefit:

- BT Mobile
- EE
- Lycamobile
- O2
- Sky Mobile
- SMARTY
- Tesco Mobile
- Three
- Virgin Mobile
- Vodafone

Other providers will join the scheme at a later stage.

Please contact the School office (contact details at the top of this letter) if you believe you are eligible for the data increase. A school leader will then contact you to collect information required to submit on your behalf.
