A Reflection for the week ahead if it is useful to you – From Andrew Smith, Director of Education, York Diocese @Sutton @Bugthorpe

Much has been said about the current situation being a marathon rather than a sprint. I have often marvelled at those who do ultra-marathons having been someone who has only ever got to half marathon territory. Any distance running involves endurance. Endurance can often be described as the ability to continue with an unpleasant or difficult situation, experience, or activity over a long period of time. We could say that endurance right now is important to us all.

We are all learning about what it means to endure in the current period. Christians often describe their spiritual life as a journey and endurance often plays a part in this journey too. There are many verses that encourage Christians to persevere and endure.

One I find helpful on the running theme is Hebrews 12 verse 1: 'let us run with endurance the race that is set before us (NKJV)'

As discussed in our Picture News Collective Worship on Thursday, Captain Sir Tom Moore said 'the sun will shine on you again....and the clouds will go away.'
