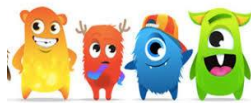


Year 2 children entered the Zen Den.

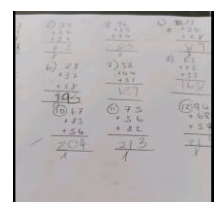
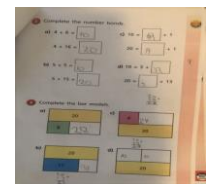
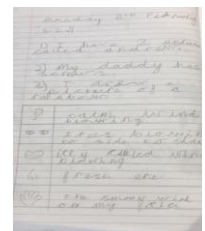
