- Dressing-Up: We would love to see your book-character costumes on Dojo or Tapestry. However, the shops are shut and delivery-drivers are quite busy enough. Please see what costumes you can come up with using items you already have at home, or make and decorate masks or hats instead!
- The Masked Reader: Teaching staff will be masking up, and you will have to guess who is reading what! We will send you links to videos of our masked readers, and you will need to tell us who you think each reader is. Out of all the children (and helpers!) who guess the most correctly, we will do a prize draw for one lucky winner.
- We're not running online learning as usual on World Book Day. Take time to read with your child, to let them read, and to listen to stories we'll be uploading. We would like your child to create a picture book theatre (You'll need about two cereal-boxes worth of cardboard) for their favorite story.
