**We are so looking forward to welcoming all the children back to school on the 8th March. Below are some reminders from NYCC.**

**If you have any queries, please to not hesitate in contacting school.**

**Looking forward to see you all!**

- Please ensure that you maintain social distancing from others when dropping off and collecting your child from our school.
- For those travelling by car we ask that you wait in your car until your specific drop off time. This will reduce the amount of people assembling around the school and will help with social distancing.
- You must keep at least two metres apart from other parents/carers at all times. Where you are unable to do so, wear a face covering.
- Please ensure your children wait sensibly and are not running up and down
- Please make sure your child attends school in **usual uniform** (no trainers) with an appropriate coat for winter conditions unless it is their PE day, in which case they should come in school PE kit with their **school jumper on**.
- Please remember the school 'bubbles' do not apply outside of school (i.e. children should avoid mixing with friends outside of school, even if they are in the same 'bubble' at school).
- Please ensure that if you or a member of your family has Covid symptoms or has been asked to self-isolate (e.g. if they are a close contact of someone who has tested positive) that you and your household follow the self-isolation guidelines.
- Please do not send a child to school if they or a member of their household has symptoms, or if they have been asked to self-isolate.
- Please follow the national guidance:
