**Congratulations** to our children who made their First Confession on Saturday and received their certificates; we pray for them and their families as they continue their journey of faith with the Church.

**Preparation for First Holy Communion:** this is open to year 4 children who have made their first confession and for the children from year 5 whose First Holy Communion was cancelled because of the Covid-19 lockdown. Application forms can be collected after Saturday vigil or Sunday morning Mass from Fr. Michael. This year the lessons will be an on-line course as a Zoom meeting and the introduction is on Monday 12th April at 6.30pm and the lessons begin the following week 19th April from 6.30pm - 7.30pm. As in previous years we planned to have the First Holy Communion Mass on Corpus Christi (6th June) but after the timetable announced by the Prime minister, we will be unable to have a full celebration until after 21st June and therefore we will delay the First Holy Communion Mass until Sunday 4th July at 11.00am with the rehearsal on Saturday 3rd July at 10.15am.

**Sunday Mass** at 11.00am has now reached our social distancing capacity and until the regulations ease in the next couple of months it is now essential to book a ticket for Mass at 11.00am. *Please remember: 1 person = 1 ticket 2 people (same household) = 1 ticket.
