Mrs Truslove writes:

School reopens to all children on Monday 8th March (gates open between 8.45am – 9.00am) and we can't wait to see you all back and raring to go. Arrangements will be similar to before Christmas and parents/carers should not enter the site unless they have made a prior appointment. I have been asked about face masks but am happy to say that the children will not be asked to wear them.

School will finish as before at 3.20pm for Reception/Year 1, 3.30pm for Years 2/3 and 3.40pm for Years 4/5/6. Siblings can leave with the youngest child.

Children should bring all of their home learning in with them on Monday for their teachers to look at. This is particularly important where work has not been regularly sent in. The red/green/blue class emails will shut down today at 5pm. Any work that is not submitted by then can be brought to school on Monday and feedback will be given in class. If you need to contact school going forward you can do this via the bursar email or phone, and someone will get back to you.

Children should continue to limit what they bring to school. They will need to bring a lunch and drink of water. There will be fruit in school for children in Years R-3 and those in Years 4-6 can bring fruit /veg from home for morning snack. Please see below for individual class information.
