Dear Parents/Carers

You have made it! A huge thank you to all of you for the last 8 weeks, you have done an amazing job home schooling your children, keeping them motivated to log on and engage with the work the teachers have set. We know and appreciate how difficult this has been for everyone, both parents and children. Home is not the ideal environment for young children to learn, but you have persevered and supported your children to access and complete work and continue to learn in a completely different way from what they are used to.

We are so looking forward to next week when the children return. I hope you have read the 'back to school' information that was sent out yesterday and I have included the details on drop off and pick up arrangements again as there has been substantial change for some year group/children. The two groups that have the biggest change are **Year 4 and the sibling group** – if you have children in these groups please take note of the collection points. Year 4 children will be collected from Walden Avenue gate and the siblings from the Key Stage 1 Hall with parents entering the school building via Askwith Road to ensure a smooth one-way system.

## Drop off

Gates **open at 8.45am and close at 9.00am** prompt. You can drop your child/children off between these times.

### Walden Avenue gate

Nursery, Reception, Year 1, Year 2 and sibling groups enter through Walden Avenue – siblings walk to their KS2 class by themselves. Parents exit through Nursery exit gate.

### Askwith Road gate

Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 enter through Askwith Road. If parents have to escort their child, they must exit through the car park pedestrian gate.

## Collection

### Walden Avenue gate (exit through Nursery gate)

- 3.10pm – Nursery and Year 2
- 3.15pm – Year 1 and Reception
- 3.20pm – Year 4

### Askwith Road gate (exit through car park)

- 3.10pm – Year 3
- 3.15pm – Year 5
- 3.20pm – **SIBLING GROUPS from KS1 Hall doors**
- 3.20pm – Year 6 exit through car park pedestrian gate

Please wear a face covering when entering the school premises. You will not be allowed on the school grounds/building without a face covering. Thank you for your cooperation with this.
