Government 'National Lockdown: Stay at Home' Guidance

While we are able to continue to hold communal celebrations of Mass during the present pandemic 'lockdown' restrictions, it is important that we continue to look after one another and remain vigilant, especially given the increased transmission rate of the new Coronavirus variant.

The use of face-coverings, hand sanitisation and social distancing (face – hands – space) remain the most effective ways to enable everyone to attend Mass safely. It is also important that we pay attention to the way we come to, and leave, the church building and premises.

For this heightened period of the pandemic, and to maintain as healthy an environment as possible, all those attending Mass are encouraged not to gather outside but to leave as promptly as possible. Similarly, clergy are being advised to refrain from greeting parishioners when they arrive or leave. In doing so at this very difficult time, we not only treat one another with care and respect but give good witness to others in our community.

TREE TAGS

Those of you who visit our graveyard may discover that the trees on the parish property have been tagged. These trees have been surveyed by a highly qualified arborist as part of our health, safety, repair, and maintenance projects. The tags, which cause no harm, are used to identify and locate each of our nearly 100 trees. These tags need to remain on the trees to ensure that they will be looked after when needed.
