

How to sign up for parents evening on Monday March 29th


The links will be available either through [Class Dojo](#) or the school [Facebook](#) page.

From feedback we have had with a trial group of parents, the advice is that this is best done on an i-pad, laptop or desktop computer. It can be done on a mobile phone, but as you progress to the diary slots they become quite small and are hard to see.

- Click on the link created for your child's class (you will be booking the slot using your child's school Google account). If you have not already done so, now is a good time to do this so you have plenty of time to get used to it.
- Click on the 'next available appointment slot on 29th March' link at the bottom of the calendar screen.
- Once there, you will see a list of meeting times.
- Hover over the slots to see the times available and when you find a time slot that suits you, please click on that slot. PLEASE ONLY BOOK 1 SLOT PER CHILD.
- You will need to log onto your child's Google account on the 29th March a five minutes before your appointment time and go into "Calendar"



- You will see your Parent evening slot in the calendar. Click once on the appointment slot with the left mouse button to open the appointment and click 'Join with Google Meet'



Things to note...

There will be only one appointment time per child. Please share your [Google Meet link](#) with another party if your child has two parents/carers who will access it from different places. Both households will need to be logged in to the child's Google account **before** they can access the calendar invite.

There will be hiccups! This is our first time doing this and we would ask you to bear with us as we sort any issues. You can help us by booking appointments ASAP and please do let us know of any problems from your end too.

We would ask that you join the meeting no less than 5 minutes before your allotted time. The class teacher will join your meeting at the appointment time (providing there are no delays)

If you join the meeting after the allotted time, the teacher will only be available for the remainder of the appointment time.

Remember to turn your video on when you join.

Finally, if you have any problems booking a slot, please let your child's teacher know and we will do our very best to help.
