Dear parents/carers,

It has been brought to our attention how hazardous it is walking along the pavement with your children to enter the school of a morning via the bottom gate.

To prevent you from having to walk this route with your children we will be changing the dropping off point from tomorrow (Tuesday 16th March). We would ask that all parents now enter school at the main gate at the front of the school. When exiting the school after dropping off your child you will need to walk across the back playground and around the periphery of the school back to your car. This way you are not having to subject your children to walking on the narrow pavement.

We will be continuing with the staggered drop off and collection times. Please do try to adhere to these to prevent a bottle neck at 8.40, when only the children with surnames A – C should be entering the school playground. We will not be opening the gate until just before 8.40, please do not arrive before this time to prevent you having to queue. The children will enter the school via the following entrances:

Fir Tree	down the side path in via classroom door
Forge	down the side path in via classroom door
Hurstwood	down the side path in via the side door (there will be a sign) and then down the corridor into their classroom
Kemsley	in through the main door
Oakwood	in via classroom door

For those children in Kemsley and Oakwood class we are happy for you to drop your child on the playground and leave via the second gate on the front playground.

We are hoping that this will ensure the children are kept safer whilst traveling to school.

Collection will not change – this will continue to be via the back gate.
