Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

We have had another week of settling everyone back into school, and we are still extremely impressed with the way the children are getting on with their learning and getting on with each other. Well done everyone!

My main message this week is about parking: We are currently operating with staggered starts and ends to the school day but it is obviously still busy at key times, particularly in the parking areas around school. The turning circle has been kept relatively clear – thank you for not parking in the turning circle at the end of a day.

Please can I just remind everyone that the roads with single yellow lines in the vicinity of school have timed restrictions and parents should not park in these areas. One area where parking considerably is extremely important is on Dale Close, directly opposite school. This is a very narrow road with single yellow lines on both sides at the bottom of the road. Thank you for your support in parking a safe distance from school and keeping this area as safe as we possibly can for pedestrians and cars. (I acknowledge that the Village Hall car park is currently where staff are parking and may be busier than normal).
