Dinners and Healthy Handy Break



A full dinner service resumes and can be booked in the normal way through 'school money'. **Please remember you must book for the day required before 11.59pm the previous day!**

After the Easter holiday, Healthy Handy Break is available to those who have paid into this scheme. School Money has currently been adjusted to reflect 2 payments instead of three. Any outstanding balances will be calculated in May.

Please Remember our One-Way System, and the wearing of Masks

Enter the playground by the narrow pedestrian gate and exit the playground by the wider double gates, which will remain open at all times. This is the same rule for both children, and adults collecting children at the end of the school day. Parents/childminders/carers should stay to the left of the YELLOW cones, follow the yellow arrows, and congregate on the hard football pitch, whilst maintaining social distancing. We ask that all parents/childminders wear a mask when congregating in the playground.

School Bus



The school bus is available in the morning to all children who hold a bus pass. In the afternoons, the bus is only available to those finishing at 2.00pm (P3-P7). Parents of children in P1 & P2 can collect older siblings at 1.30pm.
