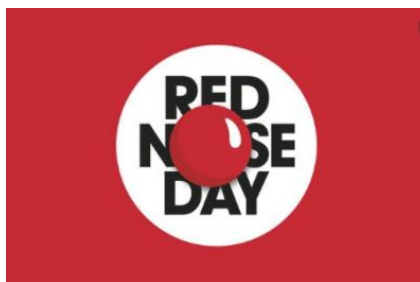

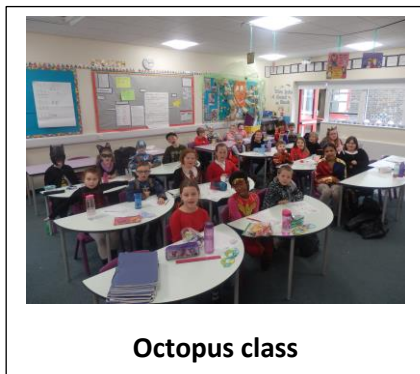
Thank you to all who gave to this very worthy cause! We have seen some very generous donations coming through. ParentPay are still accepting your donations if you have not had a chance to donate yet.

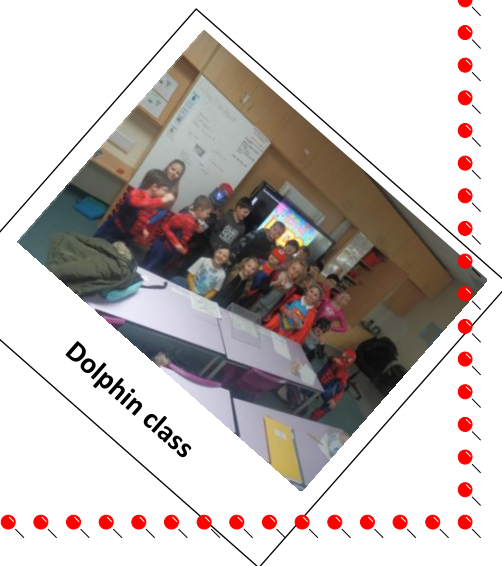
Mrs Rose
