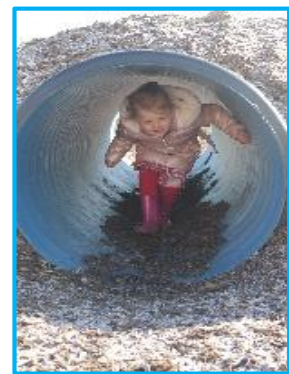
## At Mersey Drive Pupils 'Enjoy Learning; Aim High!'

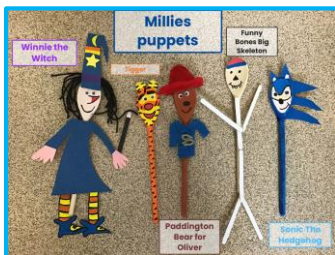
