You may remember we advertised the Royal Academy of Arts 'Summer Show' earlier this year and sent home permission forms for parents to complete. Then national lockdown hit and we obviously had to postpone getting any further with it!

If any children would now like to submit artwork they have completed at home, it has to be submitted through school so please either: Just bring it to Mr England, who will photograph the artwork and upload it for you. Or, email your own pictures of the artwork to headteacher@lindhead.n-yorks.sch.uk

The kinds of artworks that have been chosen in the past illustrate a young artists' creative imagination, originality and skill. Although many great artists 'copy' in creative ways, we would advise against submitting artworks that closely reproduce another artist's work or ideas, like popular cartoon characters, for example.

Each submission should include a short statement to accompany the work. This statement should add context to the work and often helps the judges understand the work better. Wherever possible, the statement should be written by the artist in question and should attempt to include information about why they created the work and what it means to them. (This needs to be on a separate piece of paper)

"There is no theme to the exhibition, and we accept (photos of) artworks in any medium at all, so your students have the opportunity to create a piece of work that truly expresses their own creative voice."

Please make sure you have completed a permissions form if you are submitting artwork. These are available from the school office. **The final date for submitting artwork is Friday 23rd April.**

NHS –Rapid Covid-19 Testing for Parents with Children at Nurseries, Schools and Colleges

Regular rapid testing is now available for Parents of nursery, school children and college students, as well as other adults in their households, childcare and support bubbles. This is a fast and easy way to find out if you have Coronavirus. It's free and takes around 30 minutes.

Nursery and primary school children are not being asked to be tested as evidence continues to show that children and young people are at low risk from Covid-19.

By taking part in regular rapid testing, you'll be protecting yourself and your loved ones and helping us all get back to a more normal way of life.

The test is a simple swab test you can do at home using a Lateral Flow Device (LFD). It takes around 30 minutes to find out if you have the virus. If you test negative you can go to work, if you test positive you & your household or bubble should self-isolate and the person testing positive should then take a confirmatory PCR test.

Test kits can be collected from William Street Coach Park, off Dean Road, Scarborough between 1:00 – 8:00 pm daily.

Football Club starts again!

It was wonderful to see so many children enjoying football on Friday after school! Information from last week repeated below for anyone else who wants to sign up!

Mark Barber and his 4 coaches are very excited to be able to come back in to school and start Football Club again this week. In order to stay within in the Covid-19 restrictions we can offer football club to only 5 groups – 1 coach to 1 year group to keep the children in the class bubbles. Therefore, for the moment, only children from Year 2 – Year 6 will be able to attend.

Children only need their football boots (as they should hopefully come to school in appropriate kit) and will get changed in their classroom. Coaches will meet children at the external door of their classroom and they will stay within their designated area of the field.

Please use the link above to register your child. This gives Mark consent for attendance, your contact details and permission for emergency first aid etc.


