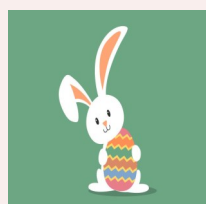
ENCOMPASS

Please check book bags regularly for homework and letters – some letters may have deadlines/require a response

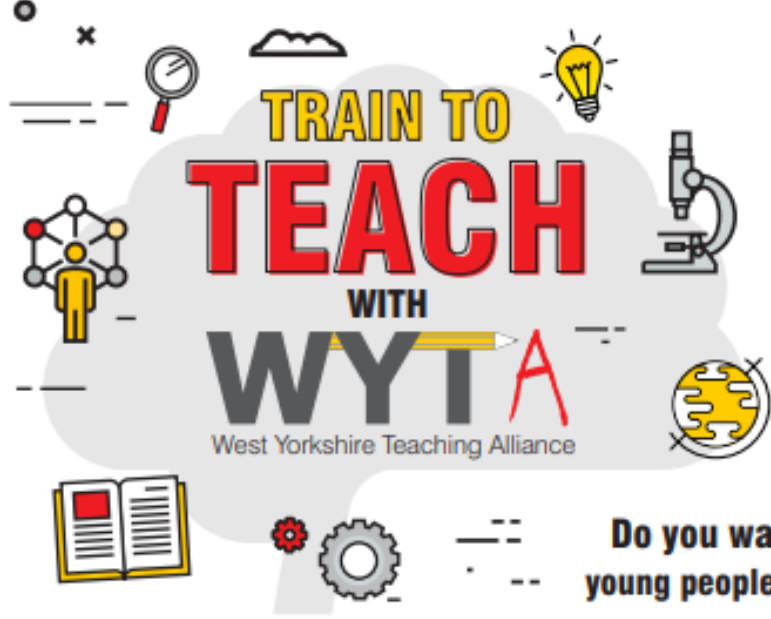
Covid-19
