Dear Parents and Carers,

This year, Roundwood Park School have devised a COVID-safe way to celebrate Easter and get out and about over the holidays: the Roundwood Park Easter Egg Hunt! We would love for the local primary schools to get involved as well!

We have hidden ten Easter eggs around Harpenden, with a letter on each. All you need to do is find them and unscramble the message we have left for you. The eggs will be hidden from the 27th of March until the 11th of April.

Here's how it will work:

- ✓ We have provided clues to the names of the roads on which you will find each egg. One is a riddle, and the other (should you need it) is an anagram of the road name.
- ✓ Once you have cracked a clue, head to that road and look for the egg it will be in a house's front window, so look high and low.
- ✓ Make a note of the letter.
- ✓ Each egg corresponds to one letter in the 10-letter phrase, so if you come across the same letter on two different eggs, it means that that letter appears more than once in the phrase.
- ✓ When you've found all ten eggs, unscramble the letters to form a message.
