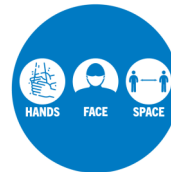

Thank you for being vigilant and spotting coronavirus symptoms.

- a **high temperature** - this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- a **new, continuous cough** - this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- a **loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** - this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had quite a busy week in school this week. On Tuesday it was lovely to see the children join in on the National Day of Reflection so sensibly and thoughtfully. This marked a year since the country first went into lockdown. The activities of hope were lovely and children have produced some excellent work.

We were also able to invite some parents to a special morning in school on Wednesday where children created posters for a 'Coventry Banner' linked to the 'Coventry City of Culture Project'.
