COVID positive case reporting (for symptoms or positive tests up to 3:30pm on 28 March)

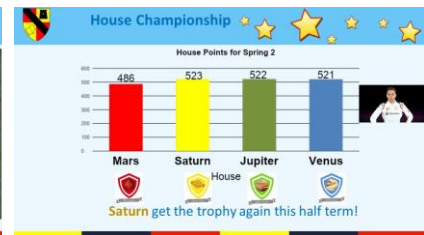
If your child was in school on Thursday 25th or Friday 26th March and receives a positive COVID test result:

- If your child receives a positive COVID test result and symptoms began on or before 3:30pm on Sunday 28th March (or is asymptomatic but the positive test was taken on or before 3:30pm on 28th March), then you can report this by emailing COVIDreporting@someriesjuniorschool.co.uk to enable us to do contact tracing.
- If the start of symptoms (or the positive test date, if your child has no symptoms) are after Sunday 28th March, you do not need to contact the school during the holidays.

Please note that our normal school office phone number and email account will not be in use during the holidays.
