### TESTING CHILDREN FOR COVID - 19 IN A PRIMARY SETTING

Please do not send your child to school if they or any of your family are displaying symptoms of Covid-19 as communicated previously.

- 1) If anyone in your family has symptoms and goes for a PCR test please keep your child at home until you receive your negative result.
- 2) If your child is sent home with a high temperature or persistent cough then please take them for a PCR test. We know this is unpleasant, but it is important that we know whether they are positive in order to protect the rest of the children and their families. If the result is positive and they have been in school we will need to close the class bubble.
- 3) Primary children do not need to have a lateral flow test. Just take them straight for a PCR if they are displaying symptoms.
- 4) Your child will not be allowed back into school until we receive the results of the PCR test, a lateral flow test will not suffice.

Thank you once again for your continued support. We must ensure that we keep everyone as safe as possible to avoid any further outbreaks. Working together as a whole school community is really important in order to do everything we can to keep children, staff, families and our wider community as safe as possible. We must all do our part in continuing to follow the rules set out by the Government and Public Health.

### Polite reminder

When entering the school grounds we ask that all parents/carers wear a **face mask and maintain a social distance**. We request that you adhere to the agreed pick up and drop off times and if you have a child in Y5/Y6 ensure they are picked up last so that they are not walking around onto the infant playground
