

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS

Please remember to follow the things that have been put in place to reduce the risk of the transmission of Covid-19 on the school premises. These include;

- Arriving at the correct times to drop off and collect your child.
- Following the one-way system of entry and exit.
- The wearing of face masks when on the school grounds.
- Maintaining social distancing from other adults.
- Ensuring that children from different bubbles, who are not siblings, do not mix with children from other bubbles at the start and end of the school day.

PARENT-GOVERNOR VACANCIES:

There are two vacancies for parents on the Governing Board of the school. If you are interested in applying for the positions, please collect a nomination form from the school office. A copy of the form will also be available on the school website for downloading. Nominees must be proposed and seconded by other parents of children attending the school, and cannot be nominated without their prior knowledge.

The Full Governing Board meets three times per year. The two sub-committees which are the Resources Committee and the Curriculum and Policies Committee also meet three times per year. Resources and Curriculum Committee Meetings are held consecutively on the same afternoon. If you would like to find out more about the role, please contact the school office. Mrs Fitton, who was a parent-governor at the school for a number of years, will be able to assist you. Parent governors serve a maximum term of 4 years.

Nominations will close on Friday 30th April. Completed nomination forms must be returned by 3.15 p.m. on that date. Should one or two nominations be received, then those nominees will be elected to the governing body unopposed. Should there be more than two nominations then an election will take place, with all parents eligible to vote. Information about the election process will be published should it be necessary.
