This week . . .

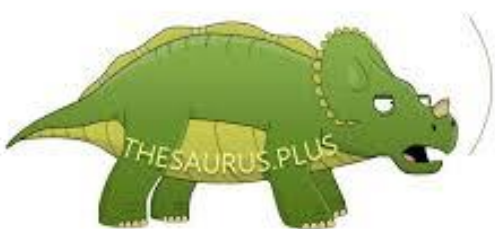
