SUMMER HOLIDAY CLUB 2021

Some of you may remember that last summer we organised a Summer Holiday Club which was extremely well received by both children and parents. I am delighted to tell you that we have decided, once again, to run a similar club for three weeks this summer during weeks commencing **2nd, 9th and 16th August which will be open to children currently in Years R - 5.**

The club will be run by our teachers and support staff each day during those three weeks from **9 am to 4 pm** and will cost £20 per day, per child. For an additional cost of £4 per day, children may arrive between 8 – 8.30 am for breakfast – booking choices can be made at the time you reserve and pay for your child's sessions. Each day will be filled with arts & crafts, games (indoor and out), sports and use of the IT suite and Creative Studio.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch (no nuts or seeds please), plenty of water to drink (no fizzy drinks please), a sunhat, suncream and a raincoat. They will need to be dressed appropriately for fun and games and we request that mobile phones/iPads/tablets etc are left at home. Children will need to be dropped off and picked up each day at the front door of the Creative Studio. Please note that we will be required to follow any Government guidelines in place at the time regarding social distancing measures.

If you would like to book your child on to our Summer Holiday Club, please complete the attached application form and return it to Joanna as soon as possible, who will then give you access on Schoolcomms/Gateway to book and pay for the days that you would like your child/ren to attend. Sessions can be paid for either by online payment (as you do when paying for a school trip) or by using childcare vouchers/tax-free childcare – please make it clear on the application form how you wish to pay. Places are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis, with no refunds made for sessions not attended. **Bookings must be made by Friday 2nd July.**
