Covid Tests

There seems to be a bit of confusion regarding the use of lateral flow testing kits. These tests are only to be used if you do not have any covid symptoms. If your child has any covid symptoms eg. cough, temp you **MUST** take them for a PCR covid test at a testing centre and keep them off school until you receive the results.

The pantry is at St Thomas's church hall, Ashton and you can park right outside. If you want to donate more money for your shop, please do, likewise if you cannot pay the £3 no one will be turned away. You won't get your whole shop here but you can get lots, save money and stop things going into land fill, therefore reducing our waste.
