We are delighted by some of the really high and increased totals of raffle tickets this term as this means children are doing lots of reading at home! Thank you for supporting your children with this.



Positive Cases of Coronavirus

A reminder that if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus any time **before 4pm on Monday 31st May** and they subsequently test positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), you must report this to Mrs Lloyd-Williams on head@finedonmulso.northants-ecl.gov.uk as soon as possible so that we can identify close contacts as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.

Return to school

School reopens on **Monday 7th June**. If your child is still self-isolating on this date, due to a positive test or due to being identified as a close contact of a positive case, then please inform us of their absence in the normal way.

Sun Safety

Now that we are starting to see some better weather, please ensure that your child has applied sunscreen before coming to school. If you wish them to reapply it before their lunch break, please supply a named bottle of sunscreen, that can be kept in their classroom. Please teach your child how to apply it, as school staff are not allowed to do this for them.

We cannot emphasise enough, how important it is to protect our skin from the harmful rays of the sun. Exposed parts of your child's skin should be covered with sunscreen, even on cloudy or overcast days.
