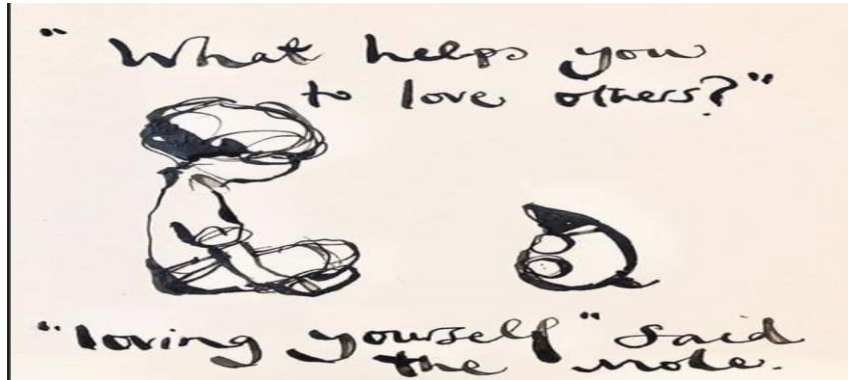


FINAL NEWSLETTER JUNE 2021
